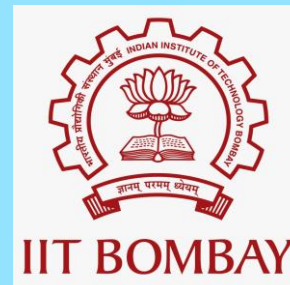
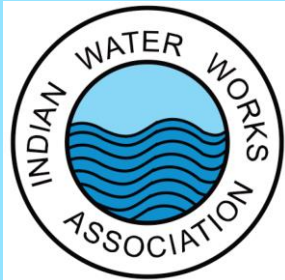

Paper format:

Paper should be in A-4 size, single space, Times new roman-12 font with a margin of one inch all sides. Maximum number of pages including figures, photos and tables shall be not more than 8 pages. The paper should have a Title, followed by authors name, photo, address, email, Abstract of paper with maximum 300 words, Introduction, methodology, results and discussion, conclusion and references.

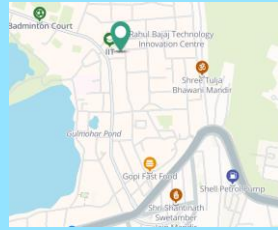
